

## **The Honourable Katherine B. Corrick appointed judge of the Superior Court of Justice**



The Honourable Katherine B. Corrick, director of policy and tribunals at the Law Society, has been appointed judge of the Superior Court of Justice of Ontario in Toronto.

Madam Justice Corrick studied psychology at the University of Toronto prior to receiving her Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) from Osgoode Hall Law School in 1979. She was called to the Ontario Bar in 1981. She started her legal career as duty counsel for the Ontario Legal Aid Plan, and in 1983 began a solo practice in criminal law.

Madam Justice Corrick joined the Law Society in 1991 as a faculty member of the bar admission course, a position she held until 1996 when she was appointed the Law Society's first director, policy secretariat.

Most recently, Madam Justice Corrick held the position of director, policy and tribunals at the Law Society. In this position, she advised the Treasurer, CEO and benchers on legal matters affecting the Law Society, including corporate governance, director's duties, administrative law and procedure.

Madam Justice Corrick was a legal member of the Ontario Review Board in 1993 and alternate chair from 1994 to 1999. She was a member of the review committee of the Association in Defence of the Wrongly Convicted and a member of the Criminal Lawyers' Association. She is an author and co-author of several publications and frequent speaker on various topics, including "The Future of the Legal Profession" and "Access to Legal Services."
